Bridge over the River Fal. Early C19. Granite rubble with granite dressings. Each side of the bridge has 2 rounded arches with granite arch rings. On the upstream side there is a roughly hewn granite cutwater, and on the downstream side a central rubble buttress. The parapet walls are about one metre high, in rubble, with rounded granite coping. The bridge is about 8 metres long and about 4 metres wide.
